KEEFE TECH ALUMNI EXCEL AS COLLEGE ATHLETES

FRAMINGHAM, MA – Two Keefe Technical School alumni recently participated in the prestigious Northeastern University Husky Track and Field Carnival on Saturday, December 6 at the Reggie Lewis Track and Field Athletic Center in Boston.

Amy Sanjurjo, a graduate of the Keefe Tech Class of 2008, is a freshman at Central Connecticut State University on a Division I Full Scholarship. Also member of the CCSU Track and Field Team, Sanjurjo finished in the top 15 of three events at the Husky Track and Field Carnival.

“Amy finished in 4th place in the 55-meter dash, in 10th place in the long jump, and 14th in the 200-meter dash,” said Ken Collins, Keefe Tech Assistant Principal. “While she attended Keefe Tech, Amy was a very talented athlete on our Track & Field Team. It is no surprise to me that she is still competing on a team and has continued to excel.”

Patience Noah, also a Class of 2008 graduate, is a freshman at the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth. As a member of the college’s Track and Field Team, Noah competed in the triple jump and the 400-meter dash. “Patience was such an active athlete when she was a student at Keefe,” Collins noted. “She played on the basketball team and was also a member of the Track Team.”

“It’s wonderful to see two of our outstanding former student athletes doing so well both on the field and academically,” Collins added. “They had four years of success here at Keefe and I’m so proud of both of them and all they have accomplished.”
